All effort and appropriate resources will be sanctioned to maintain as far as is reasonably possible a safe environment.

The Health & Safety Policy will be revised and updated accordingly to meet with legislation, as a result of experience or from input by employees and or sub-contractors, in an effort to maintain the highest possible standards. The Company expects the full support of all persons to comply with and improve by constructive comment, the established working procedures as detailed in the Company's safety manuals (method statements and risk assessments).

Where a site induction is undertaken by the main Contractor, all employees and sub-contractors shall adhere to the sites rules and observe any specific instructions, restrictions or demands made by the contractor.

Where there is no site induction, or where the site doesn't provide for the following,

- Reporting and recording accidents.
- Fire precautions, fire drill and evacuation procedures.
- First aid.
- Safety inspections.

Mr M Rigg or Mr A Greenwood will be responsible and should be consulted on any Health and Safety matter.

Vacrite Ltd wishes to encourage the initiative of all in generating a pro-active safety environment particularly in the fields of competence to carry out the tasks and risk management during works. To develop this the Company will sanction funds and provide access to information, instruction and training for the mutual benefit of the Company and its employees and sub-contractors. The Company is also mindful of the special risks presented to young and inexperienced persons and expects everyone to allow for this and to help and guide them accordingly.

Vacrite Ltd expects full commitment to the generation of a safe environment at work and will not tolerate any compromise on safety.
